At “CrossCounsel Dallas” we have a holy fear – watching God move the light of His truth into very dark areas. God has called us into a fragile and sacred arena: the sex trafficking of minors (the buying and selling of our children). We’ve been to specialized training through “Traffick911” (a national organization based here). We have begun to get involved, through outreaches and prayer.

As you may have experienced, when you take a step of faith, God sometimes has plans for you beyond your imagination.

Just recently, we were invited to go on a missions trip in March to the House of Hope, a ministry based in Managua, Nicaragua, working to bring freedom to young girls trapped in prostitution. We will be ministering to pre-teen girls and their mothers, who use prostitution to put food on the table. Because of our expertise in transformational prayer ministry, Steve and I have been asked to return in the fall to develop a TPM ministry team on site.
